

LETTER OF AGREEMENT  
(Required for all campers)

There are a few specific requirements of Smith Rock Climbing Camp, involving serious issues we ask each camper to agree with to share and maintain a physical and emotional safe and equal environment for all participants.

Take some time to carefully read the following and discuss with your son or daughter. It is mandatory that the following be understood and agreed to in order to attend Smith Rock Climbing Camp.

1. We will treat each other and our physical environment with respect and strive to address issues and conflicts as a community with empathy, common sense and to the best positive outcome. Violent action or threatening behavior to any person/s or environment(wildlife, trees, trails,etc) will not be tolerated on any level.
2. As for all of our programs, there will be no alcohol, tobacco (cigarettes or smokeless), or other drugs allowed at Smith Rock Climbing Camp. We reserve the right to check the camper's person or belongings if any of the above items are suspected.
3. In addition, matches and lighters are not allowed on person at Smith Rock Climbing Camp. In the high desert environment where we are located, fire danger is extreme in the summer. A single match can start a small brush fire that grows to tremendous intensity, causing death and destruction in its wake. Currently there is a year round fire ban at Smith Rock.
4. It is normal for young teenagers to develop romantic interests in other teens. If this occurs during camp, the kids involved must behave in a manner that is respectful and appropriate to others. Absolutely no public displays of affection other than the affection that is commonly displayed between friends. It can be very uncomfortable for the other kids to be around two campers that have developed a romantic interest in each other. If a relationship becomes consistently disruptive or distracting to other camp participants or activities it is in violation.
5. Day use of smart device (cell phones) or any electronic games will be restricted. **There will be NO Smart phone use during the climbing day.** This includes: social media interaction, text or voice calls or any internet use). If you do not have a camera, cell devices may limited to photos only. We will allow and encourage communication with family members, guardians at appropriate times in the evenings. Use of cell phone for any reason other than communication at appropriate times is at the discretion of the Camp Director.  
Parents: please let us know if there are any parameters you may wish to have us follow.

Should a camper be found in possession of any of the above mentioned items, or behavior disregarding these points of agreement, it may/will represent grounds for immediate expulsion from camp. The parent or guardian will be contacted and must arrange for the camper to return home immediately.
